This office vide letter cited under reference (2) above advised relief given to Non Fare Revenue contracts due to COVID-19 pandemic. Wherein, it was advised that 90 days of relaxation in Licence Fee is granted to existing operational contracts, by treating the period from 25.03.2020 to 22.06.2020 as dies-non. Further divisions are advised to consider the relief given to contracts under the existing terms and conditions which provide for addition/modification/review in existing agreement with mutual consent, with concurrence of Finance.

Board vide letter cited under reference (1) advised Zonal Railways after relief given to NFR contracts revenue loss due to COVID-19 negative impact on Commercial Publicity and Advertisement revenue may please be advised the revenue to be generated to the end of the FY 2020-21. The actual extra revenue could be generated by Railways during forth coming months till March, 2021 may also be advised.

In view of the relief given to NFR contracts, divisions are advised to give the breakup of each kind of relief granted by the division, the revised estimate targets for the year 2020-21 with justification to be furnished in the format enclosed by 15.09.2020 for forward communication to Railway Board by due date.
