Sub: Extension of contract period of 13 halt stations over BZA division - Reg.

It is to submit that Halt contracts at 13 (Thirteen) Halt stations over BZA division – Pasivedala, Timmapuram, Brahmanagudem, Vugunturu, Chiluvuru, Modukuru, Machavaram, Ipurupalem, Jandrapeta, Kottapandillapalli, Kadavakuduru, Raparla and Veeravalli are extended as detailed below.

Pasivedala (PSDA) Halt station was extended to Sri K. Veera Raghavulu, for a period of 5
years from 12-03-2016 to 11-03-2021.

In view of lockdown, unreserved ticketing stopped from 23-03-2020 and the period of original contract was upto 11-03-2021. Therefore the inoperative period is 354 days.

In this connection, it is requested to arrange to extend the period of Halt agent at Pasivedala Halt Station for 354 days up to 10-04-2023 from 22-04-2022 (the date of commencement of stoppage of the above train at PSDA).

 Timmapuram (TMPM) Halt station was awarded to Sri Ch. Venkata Kishore, for a period of 5 years from 07-10-2015 to 06-10-2020.

In view of lockdown, unreserved ticketing stopped from 23-03-2020 and the period of original contract was upto 06-10-2020. Therefore the inoperative period is 198 days.

In this connection, it is requested to arrange to extend the period of Halt agent at Timmapuram Halt Station for 198 days up to 05-11-2022 from 22-04-2022 (the date of commencement of stoppage of the above train at TMPM).

 Brahmanagudem (BMGM) Halt station was awarded to Sri D.V.V. Krishna, for a period of 5 years from 07-10-2015 to 06-10-2020.

In view of lockdown, unreserved ticketing stopped from 23-03-2020 and the period of original contract was upto 06-10-2020. Therefore the inoperative period is 198 days.

In this connection, it is requested to arrange to extend the period of Halt agent at Brahmanagudem Halt Station for 198 days up to 05-11-2022 from 22-04-2022 (the date of commencement of stoppage of the above train at BMGM).

4. Vunguturu (VGT) Halt station was awarded to Sri N. Venkateswara Rao, for a period of 5 years from 08-10-2015 to 07-10-2020.

In view of lockdown, unreserved ticketing stopped from 23-03-2020 and the period of original contract was upto 07-10-2020. Therefore the inoperative period is 199 days.

In this connection, it is requested to arrange to extend the period of Halt agent at Vunguturu Halt Station for 199 days up to 06-11-2022 from 22-04-2022 (the date of commencement of stoppage of the above train at VGT).

5. Chiluvuru (CLVR) Halt station was awarded to Sri N. Mariyadas, for a period of 5 years from 13-10-2015 to 12-10-2020.

In view of lockdown, unreserved ticketing stopped from 23-03-2020 and the period of original contract was upto 12-10-2020. Therefore the inoperative period is 204 days.

In this connection, it is requested to arrange to extend the period of Halt agent at Chiluvuru Halt Station for 204 days up to 11-11-2022 from 22-04-2022 (the date of commencement of stoppage of the above train at CLVR).

6. Modukuru (MDKU) Halt station was awarded to Sri T. Venkata Reddy, for a period of 5 years from 0S-10-2015 to 07-10-2020.

In view of lockdown, unreserved ticketing stopped from 23-03-2020 and the period of original contract was upto 07-10-2020. Therefore the inoperative period is 199 days.

In this connection, it is requested to arrange to extend the period of Halt agent at Modukuru Halt Station for 198 days up to 06-11-2022 from 22-04-2022 (the date of commencement of stoppage of the above train at MDKU).

7. Machavaram (MCVM) Halt station was awarded to Smt. M. Madhavi, for a period of 5 years from 07-10-2015 to 06-10-2020.

In view of lockdown, unreserved ticketing stopped from 23-03-2020 and the period of original contract was upto 06-10-2020. Therefore the inoperative period is 198 days.

In this connection, it is requested to arrange to extend the period of Halt agent at Machavaram Halt Station for 198 days up to 05-11-2022 from 22-04-2022 (the date of commencement of stoppage of the above train at MCVM).

8. **Ipurupalem** (IPPM) Halt station was awarded to Smt. G. Suneetha, for a period of 5 years from 27-10-2015 to 26-10-2020.

In view of lockdown, unreserved ticketing stopped from 23-03-2020 and the period of original contract was upto 26-10-2020. Therefore the inoperative period is 218 days.

In this connection, it is requested to arrange to extend the period of Halt agent at Ipurupalem Halt Station for 218 days up to 25-11-2022 from 22-04-2022 (the date of commencement of stoppage of the above train at IPPM).

9. Jandrapeta (JAQ) Halt station was awarded to Sri K. Venka Reddy, for a period of 5 years from 22-06-2017 to 21-06-2022.

In view of lockdown, unreserved ticketing stopped from 23-03-2020 and the period of original contract was upto 21-06-2022. Therefore the inoperative period is 821 days.

In this connection, it is requested to arrange to extend the period of Halt agent at Jandrapeta Halt Station for 821 days up to 21-07-2024 (the original contract is upto 21-06-2022) from 22-04-2022 (the date of commencement of stoppage of the above train at IAQ).

10. Kottapandillapalli (KPLL) Halt station was extended to Sri P. Chennakesava Rao, for a period of 2 ½ years from 19-09-2018 to 18-03-2021.

In view of lockdown, unreserved ticketing stopped from 23-03-2020 and the period of original contract was upto 18-03-2021. Therefore the inoperative period is 361 days.

In this connection, it is requested to arrange to extend the period of Halt agent at Kottapandillapalli Halt Station for 361 days up to 17-04-2023 from 22-04-2022 (the date of commencement of stoppage of the above train at KPLL).

11. Kadavakuduru (KVDU) Halt station was extended to Sri G. Venkata Ramaiah, for a period of 2 ½ years from 19-10-2019 to 18-04-2022.

In view of lockdown, unreserved ticketing stopped from 23-03-2020 and the period of original contract was upto 18-04-2022. Therefore the inoperative period is 757 days.

In this connection, it is requested to arrange to extend the period of Halt agent at Kadavakuduru Halt Station for 757 days up to 18-05-2024 from 22-04-2022 (the date of commencement of stoppage of the above train at KVDU).

12. Raparla (RPRL) Halt station was awarded to Sri P. Siva Reddy, for a period of 5 years from 27-10-2015 to 26-10-2020.

In view of lockdown, unreserved ticketing stopped from 23-03-2020 and the period of original contract was upto 26-10-2020. Therefore the inoperative period is 218 days.

In this connection, it is requested to arrange to extend the period of Halt agent at Raparla Halt Station for 198 days up to 25-11-2022 from 22-04-2022 (the date of commencement of stoppage of the above train at RPRL).

13. Veeravalli (VRVL) Halt station was extended to Smt. B. Jyothi, for a period of 2 ½ years from 11-02-2020 to 10-08-2022.

In view of lockdown, unreserved ticketing stopped from 23-03-2020 and the period of original contract was upto 10-08-022. Therefore the inoperative period is 871 days.

In this connection, it is requested to arrange to extend the period of Halt agent at Veeravalli Halt Station for 871 days up to 09-09-2024 (the original contract is upto 10-08-2022) from 22-04-2022 (the date of commencement of stoppage of the above train at VRVL).

DRM's approval and Finance concurrence has been taken for extension of inoperative period in the wake of Covid-19 from 23-03-2020 to till commencement of ticketing activities is enclosed herewith.
