

Sir,

As you are aware, Ministry of Home Affairs has from time to time specified courtesies to be shown to VIPs on their visits to States and Union Territories. A compilation of such courtesies currently in vogue is enclosed.

- 2. Government of India have now decided that former Presidents. former Vice-Presidents and former Prime Ministers on their visits to States/Union Territories should be extended the same courtesies as extended to Union Cabinet Ministers on their official visits to States/Union Territories. It has also been decided that they should be extended appropriate courtesies while making a night halt or transit halt in the States/Union Territories.
- 3. Accordingly, a new para 4(a) as indicated below has been inserted just below para 4 of the compilation related to "Courtesies to be shown to VIPs on their visits to States and Union Territoric."

"4(a) FORMER PRESIDENTS. FORMER VICE-PRESIDENTS AND FORMER PRIME MINISTERS These dignitaries on their visit to the States/UTs should be extended the same courtesies as extended to the Union Cabinet Ministers on their official visits to States/UTs. Further, these dignitaries should also be extended appropriate courtesies while they make a night halt or transit halt in the States/UTs.

4. It is requested that the contents of para 3 above may kindly be brought to the notice of all concerned for necessary action.
