“

1. Adequate manning of the gates at Railway stations and also in the trains to keep a check on without ticket/unauthorized travelling.
2. Opening of adequate Reservation counters at PRS centers as well as at stations to cater to the requirement of passengers for regular as well as last minute bookings.
3. Making regular announcements at Railway stations as well as at PRS counters to inform passengers that these trains are fully reserved trains.
4. Adequate publicity through all available means to inform passengers about these fully reserved trains and informing that no passengers should come to the Railway stations without a reserved ticket.”
