Railway Board had sanctioned various projects for the procurement of Hand-Held Terminals (HHT) and TTE lobbies at major stations of Indian Railways. Zonal Railways (SN 2 & 3 above) had approached this office, seeking guidelines about procurement of additional equipment in case of fresh recruitments in ticket checking cadre or when additional lobbies are planned under their respective jurisdictions.

- 2. This office had approached Railway Board regarding guidelines for such procurements. The salient features of the guidelines as received from Board (SN 1 above) is as under:
  - (a) Zonal Railways may process procurement of fresh equipment in terms of Para no B (1) (2) (d) (i) of Boards letter no 2022/ F(X) II/ PW/ 4 dated 25.7.2022 (*Annexure B*), within the powers are delegated to General Managers to sanction works under Plan Head 17 (Computerization) upto `2.50 Cr including the cost of hardware replacement for IT based network applications.
  - (b) In case, the procurement/ replacement of a higher value is proposed, Zonal Railways could approach Railway Board for inclusion of the proposal under Work Program.
  - (c) These procurements should be done only in case of fresh recruitments in the ticket checking cadre and/ or when additional lobbies are planned.
- 3. Zonal Railway may proceed as per the above guidelines and as per the specifications for these equipments shared by CRIS.
- 4. It's emphasized that Zonal Railway should ensure compatibility of various equipment being procured on additional account only after conducting a <u>Proof of Concept (POC) and proper testing prior to procurement</u> so that functionality and smooth functioning of system is not compromised.

Northern Railway vide letter referred at (1) above has requested that any further procurement of Hand Held Terminals for TTEs and equipment for TTE Lobbies (in addition to already sanctioned works for HHTs for TTEs and TTE Lobbies) may be done by Zonal Railways under the powers delegated to General Managers vide Board's letter referred at (2) above and in case the procurement/replacement of a higher value is proposed, Zonal Railways could approach Railway Board for inclusion of the proposals under the Works Programme.

The above request of Northern Railway has been accepted. The procurement of the equipments for Hand Held Terminals for TTEs and TTE lobbies may be done by the Zonal Railways themselves by sanctioning the same under PH -17, as per their local requirement. These equipments may be procured only after the full utilization of equipments sanctioned in the works of Hand Held Terminals for TTEs and TTE Lobbies under the Plan Head – 17 (Computerization) and procurement should be done only in case of fresh recruitments in the ticket checking cadre and/or when additional TTE lobbies are planned, under the respective jurisdictions of the Zonal Railways.

This issues in consultation with Passenger Marketing and Finance Directorates of Ministry of Railways.

Subject: Request from Zonal Railways for Procurement of additional HHTs & equipment for TTE lobbies – reg

Railway Board have sanctioned the under-mentioned projects for procurement of equipment for TTE lobbies and Hand-Held Terminal (HHT) for the ticket checking staff over Indian Railways:

a) Computerization of TTE Lobbies at Interchange /Major stations on 67 divisions of Indian Railways – 199 stations.

b) Proliferation of computerized TTE Lobbies over Indian Railways - at 573 stations including replacement of equipment at 199 stations of Phase-I.

 Proliferation for HHTs for TTEs deployed in trains on ticket checking duties over Indian Railways - (10000 HHTs).

d) Pan Indian rollout of HHTs for TTEs – (18240 HHTs).

Now, various Zonal Railways have approached this office, seeking guidelines
about procurement of equipment in case of fresh recruitments in the ticket checking
cadre or when additional lobbies are planned, under their respective jurisdictions.

3. In this regard, Board's kind attention is invited to Para No. B(I)(2)(d)(i) of letter No. 2022/ F(X)II/ PW/4 dated 25.07.2022 (copy enclosed), wherein powers have been delegated to General Managers to sanction works under Plan Head 17 (Computerization) upto ₹ 2.50 crore including cost of hardware replacement for IT-based network applications.

This office is of the considered view that any further procurement should be made by Zonal Railways under the aforesaid delegation. In case, procurement/replacement of a higher value is proposed, Zonal Railway could approach Railway Board for inclusion of the proposal under the Works Programme.

Railway Board may like to issue suitable directive on the above proposal.
