## Sub: HMIS Webinar for Patients or Railway Medical Beneficiaries

  - O How to create ABHA (Ayushman Bharat Health Account) IDs for Patients?
  - How to link Records to ABHA and view Linked Records in ABDM PHR App.
- Release of New Version of Mobile App & HMIS videos & Brochures by DG/RHS.
