Sub:- Hospital linen and Railway Bedroll washing in same laundry.

Ref:- Railway Board's letter No. 2017/EnHM/26/04 dated 08.07.2020.

As train services during Covid-19 pandemic were restricted and linen was not supplied in trains, instructions were issued vide Board's letter referred to above, to explore the possibility of diverting washing load of linen items from Running Rooms, Rest houses, Training institutes/hostels, Railway Hospitals etc. in nearest mechanized laundry so that washing machines could be in operative conditions without having any maintenance issues and to provide minimum load as per minimum assured off-take clause.

2. With the easing out of COVID-19 pandemic situation and restoration of linen supply in trains, the aforesaid instructions are partially modified and it has been decided that hospital linen and bedroll supplied in trains are washed in separate laundries. Railways are requested to kindly ensure the same.
