Sub: Incentives for acquiring higher qualifications.

Ref: Railway Board's letter No. E(Trg)94(28)/1 dated 17.04.2000.

Consequent upon recommendations of the VIIth CPC and as notified by DoPT vide their Office Memorandum No. 1/5/2017-Estt(Pay-I) dated 15th March, 2019, it is, hereby, communicated that in supersession of all the existing instructions on the subject of granting incentive for acquiring higher qualification, the following one-time lump-sum rates as Incentive for acquiring fresh higher qualification by a railway servant shall be permissible for courses in fields that are directly relevant to the employee's job:

- 2. The incentive shall be limited to maximum two times in a railway sevant's career, with a minimum gap of two years between successive grants.
- 3. The list of qualifications, the acquisition of which shall entitle the railway servant for grant of lump sum incentive is mentioned in the Annexure to this letter.

- 4. Criteria/guidelines for granting incentive for acquiring fresh higher qualifications by a railway servant shall be as follows:
 - i. Incentive shall be admissible to all serving railway servant.
 - ii. Incentive shall be allowed for the qualifications, the acquisitions of which is directly related to the functions of the post held by the Railway servant or the functions to be performed in the next higher post and the qualifications should contribute to the efficiency of the Railway servant. In the case of qualifications being useful in the discharge of functions in the next higher post, the grant of incentive may be considered on actual promotion to the higher grade.
 - iii. Incentive will not be allowed for acquiring higher qualification on purely academic or literary subjects and accordingly, incentives need not be considered for qualification like Degree in Humanities.
 - iv. The incentive shall not be admissible for the qualifications which are laid down as essential or desirable qualifications in the recruitments rules for the post.
 - v. The quantum of incentive will be uniform for all posts irrespective of their classification or grade or the department.
 - vi. The incentive shall not be admissible where the railway servant is sponsored by the Railways or he/she avails study leave for acquiring the qualification. Only those officials who have acquired the higher qualification fully at their own cost and where the Railways have not borne any part of the expenses will be entitled for grant of incentives.
 - vii. The incentive would be given only for higher qualification acquired after induction into service and not for possession of higher qualification at the time of entry in service.
 - viii. No incentive would be admissible if an appointment is made in relaxation of the educational qualifications. No incentive would be admissible if railway servant acquires the requisite qualification for such appointment at a later date.
 - ix. The qualifications meriting grant of incentive should be recognised by the University Grant Commission, respective regulatory bodies like All India Council for Technical Education(AICTE), Medical Council of India, Department of Electronics, Deemed University etc. set up by Central/State Government or recognized by the Government.
 - x. The railway servant should prefer the claim within six months from the date of acquisition of the higher qualification.
 - xi. Officials who avail the incentives should remain in service for at least three years after acquiring higher qualifications.
- 5. The incentives mentioned in para 1 above will be admissible for the qualification acquired on or after 01.07.2017. In other words, the qualifications specified in the Annexure acquired on or after 01.07.2017 only will qualify for the amount of specified lump sum incentive. For this purpose, the last date of the prescribed examination shall be considered as the date of acquiring the qualifications and not the date of publication of the results, subject to successful completion of the course.
- 6. Railway servants, who have acquired the fresh higher qualifications on or after 01.07.2017 till the date of issuance of these instructions, may also claim these incentives within six months from the date of issuance of these instructions.
