TIMETABLES

Indian Railways revises time table once in a year, that is on July 1st of every year.

Classification of Timetables: -

1. Public Time Table: -

- I) Printed in English and regional languages.
- II) Contain time schedules, fare tables of different trains.
- III) Useful variety of information to travelling Passengers.

2. Suburban Time Table: -

- I) These are of pocket size and printed in English and Bengali (and respective languages in some other zones) languages.
- II) Detailed timings of suburban services and other passenger services running through suburban section as well as abstract timings of other main line Passenger services.

3. Sheet Time Table: -

- I) Painted in English and regional languages.
- II) Exhibited on Plat forms and on waiting halls.

4. **Staff Copy Time Table: -** Meant for use by Rly staff only such as true copies like public Time Tables.
