Classification of Timetables: -

1. Public Time Table: -

- Printed in English and regional languages. D
- Contain time schedules, fare tables of different trains. II)
- III) Useful variety of information to travelling Passengers.

2. Suburban Time Table: -

- These are of pocket size and printed in English and Bengali (and I) respective languages in some other zones) languages.
- Detailed timings of suburban services and other passenger services II) running through suburban section as well as abstract timings of other main line Passenger services.

3. Sheet Time Table: -

- Painted in English and regional languages. I)
- Exhibited on Plat forms and on waiting halls. II)
- Staff Copy Time Table: Meant for use by Rly staff only such as true 4 copies like public Time Tables.
