Prashant Kumar Dy.CME/LGDS (Now Sr.DME/NED)

Shri Prashant Kumar has been instrumental in the implementation of modernization projects at Lallaguda Workshop like construction of new shed for retrospective shop, renovation of staff canteen, construction of new classroom building for BTC and modern toilets for employees etc. It is because of his constant efforts, LGD Workshop has received "Best Establishment Award" from "Ministry of Skill Development/Government of India" and "Telangana State Government" while serving as Principal/BTC for the year 2019. He was instrumental in Conceptualizing, designing, development and direction of LHB workstation for LHB bogie maintenance (first time in Indian Railway workshop).









M. Basava Raj Sr.DCM/SC

Mr Basavaraj M is an outstanding Officer who played key role in improving train operations in Guntakal division. By virtue of his hard work and continuous monitoring division has seen perceptible changes in all spheres of train operations. The punctuality percentage of division has been 83.97% from April to December 19, when compared to 78.42% logged during the corresponding period of last year. His meticulous planning and execution led to successful completion of NI works of GPU-GTL section and KDT-GDE section. The division under his leadership in operations could also undertake 87 Bridge blocks for elimination of Non-interlocked LC Gates and replacement of stone top culverts with RCC boxes.

SSE/P.Way/Bhimavaram attended the rail breakage at the spot and track was given fit with SR 30 KMPH at 06.45 hrs. His commitment towards safety, optimistic observation and prompt action in reporting the track abnormality has averted a major possible disaster to train service.









Boya Thirupal Tech-I/Sig./M/GTL (Now Sr.Tech/Sig/SRM/GTL)

Sri Boya Thirupal has very good knowledge in Signalling system and he is involved in almost all the special and newly commissioned works over this Guntakal Division. D. Narendra Varma Sr.DCM/Guntur

Shri D. Narendra Varma through his persistent efforts has ensured early commissioning of Private Freight Terminal at Nagireddipalli and commenced its operations from 09.05.2020 which has fetched an additional freight revenue of Rs. 23.42 Cr. through loading of 64 rakes of Boiled Rice. Due to his sincere efforts, the actual total Freight Revenue of Guntur Division registered a positive growth rate of 110.99% during the period of January' 20 to December' 20 and actual freight revenue of Rs. 339.15 crores was realised as against Rs. 160.74 crores as compared to the corresponding period of previous year.


Y.Vinay Kumar SSE/EM/Gooty


Mritunjay Kumar Sr.ALP/BTTR/BZA


P. Karuna Sagar Tech-II/ ELS/BZA
